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MRI cervical spine.

Comparison December 17, 2013.

There is reversal of the normal cervical lordosis centered at C4. The craniovertebral junction is unremarkable. Vertebral body height and signal is normal.

The level at C2-3 shows no significant abnormality.

C3-4 minimal anterolisthesis of C3 and C4 with mild disc bulging and mild left foraminal narrowing is stable.

At C4-5 minimal anterolisthesis of C4-5 with disc bulge and mild left foraminal stenosis is stable.

At C5-6 there is significant improvement in the osteochondral bar which is asymmetric to the left side. On today's examination there is no significant central stenosis but there is persistent moderate left foraminal narrowing.

The level at C6-7 and C7-T1 is unremarkable.

IMPRESSION-

Slight improvement in the appearance of the C5-6 asymmetric left-sided abnormality.
